

Duties of Travel Team Rep

General responsibilities

In general this position is to communicate the requirements for our teams to play within NPHSL or ESL.

Understanding of the league requirements

NPHSL is the group that the U16/U18 kids play in. It is run out of PHSA umbrella, so for HEADS, who play under the SWRSA umbrella, these teams require playing out forms which any coach / assistant / manager who will be on the bench will be required to sign

ESL is the group that the U12/U14 kids play in. It is run out of the SWRSA umbrella so for HEADS no playing out forms are required.

Duties

- Attend the NPHSL/ESL meetings (typical timing Jan, Feb, Mar, April, May, Nov)
- Attend HEADS council meetings and share requirements for the year.
- Communicate with the appropriate coaches / HEADS convenors / NPHSL/ESL convenors or executives the needs/requirements of the league.
- Ensure that HEADS teams are eligible to play by following up as required (ie teams have signed rosters)

Rosters

Rosters are provided by the HEADS administrator and are forwarded to the HEADS convenors.
