Elite Coaching Comes Back to HEADS

Last year many of your children had the opportunity to be coached

by **Djiba Camara**. The feedback from parents was very positive and we saw some great results with many of the travelling teams winning or coming in 2nd in their leagues (U18B, U18G, U14G etc.).

We were also fortunate to have the goaltending expertise of **Ben Uzoagba** helping out many of our aspiring keepers.

2011 will see an increased involvement of Djiba Camara and Ben with HEADS players.

Beginning in May Djiba will work with HEADS to improve the skills of the Coaches, showing them drills, proper ways of kicking and ball control and ways to make learning new skills fun.

U5 to U10 will have significantly more age specific focus put on them this year with the addition of 2 coaches to help Djiba develop the skills of our younger players. They can expect to have regular coaching during the week in addition to 2 Saturday "mini" camps from 9:00 to 12:00 in July. Specific dates will be posted for these during registration.

U12 and up will have Djiba and one of his Assistants participate or lead at least 2 of their practices. Learning from last year, Djiba will be available during fixed times, 3-4 nights of the week, and teams can book times with him. The schedule will also be available for parents to view to ensure all are aware of his availability.

Keeper is the one position that can make and break a team. It requires special talents and training. HEADS has hired Ben Uzoagba to help develop their unique skills. Ben was recruited from his home in Nigeria to play with Pirate FC South Africa and brings his years of Goalie training to HEADS. He will coach in small groups of 1 to 4 players at a time during the evenings.
